I approve the staff's recommendation to host an Integrated Regulatory Review Service (IRRS) mission focused exclusively on materials activities, facilities, and exposure scenarios under the NRC's Atomic Energy Act jurisdiction (option 3). This is a meaningful opportunity to reaffirm our leadership in nuclear safety and security, while advancing our commitment to continuous learning and global collaboration. A materials-focused mission allows us to share our progress, gain valuable peer insights, and strengthen public trust—all without compromising our ability to deliver on high-priority domestic work. The staff should request this mission 3 years after the date of the SRM to allow for full implementation of new processes following the ADVANCE Act and Executive Order 14300.

Given the dynamic nature of the reactor program—especially in light of the ADVANCE Act and the increasing pace of licensing activity—now is not the right time to include reactors in the scope of an IRRS mission. That said, the staff should continue to evaluate when a reactor-focused mission might be appropriate in the future.
