## SECY-25-0086 – FINAL RULE [FR-3]: STREAMLINING SELECT RULES OF PRACTICE AND PROCEDURE (RIN 3150-AL54)

The Commission approved a final rule to rescind a discrete number of regulations in Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations Parts 2 and 14 because they are either inconsistent with statutory requirements or duplicative of statutory requirements and other binding regulations, subject to the enclosed changes. These rules govern the conduct of NRC proceedings or internal agency practices, and this action will not impinge on the substantive rights of any party. The Commission has also certified, under the Regulatory Flexibility Act, that this rule will not have significant economic impact on a substantial number of small entities.

Following incorporation of the changes, the *Federal Register* notice should be reviewed by the Regulatory Analysis and Rulemaking Support Branch in the Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards and forwarded to the Office of the Secretary for signature and publication.
