2. We confirm our facilities and their associated safety measures are prepared to handle the increased Lu-177 activity. Our radioactive waste storage facility is more than adequate to handle an increased volume of waste due to the potential long-lived Lu-177m contaminant. We confirm, if Lu-177m is detected by survey methods, then it will be disposed of as low-level radioactive waste through an authorized waste vendor.
