In addition, we will **not** be rolling over the applications received from previous year submissions. New applications must be submitted for the fiscal year 2025 courses. A letter of acceptance will be issued 8 to 10 weeks prior to the course start date. Priority is not given to early applicants, as all applicants will be considered at the due date. The letter of acceptance will contain specific guidance relating to travel and per diem and will provide the students with information relating to their responsibilities. Upon acceptance, if an individual is no longer available to attend the course, notification **must** be provided immediately so the individual can be replaced.
