SUBJECT: Request for Additional Information – IRISNDT, Inc.

Dear John Wojno,

We have reviewed your license amendment request dated March 19, 2025 and email responses submitted in July, 2025, and have determined that additional information is required for continued processing of the licensing action. As such, for continued timely review of this application, please provide your response to the following items:

1. Please provide a signed and dated copy of a Delegation of Authority memo formally documenting Mr. Wojno's responsibilities in the RSO position. A model delegation of authority is attached and should be signed by both Mr. Wojno and someone in his senior management chain.
2. Providing a copy of an organizational chart, by position, demonstrating day-to-day oversight and coordination with management in radiation safety activities. This is requested to support demonstration of RSO independence and direct communication with responsible management officials.
3. Indicate whether or not industrial radiography will also be performed at the site of the new proposed field station. If so, please provide a diagram of the location where industrial radiography may be performed on-site and its surroundings, including a description of adjacent property.
4. Please provide a statement committing to implementing security measures that meet the requirements of 10 CFR Part 37 at your new proposed field station, equivalent to those at your existing approved field stations. Please provide a description of any differences in security features between this location and your existing approved field stations.
5. Source retrieval training records have been received for Brian Block, Kyle Ledbetter, and John Wojno. Please clarify if there are any other individuals (previously named individuals include Micah Wilson, Josh White, Clinton Schreck, Chris Salinas, Justin Johnson, and Josh Coons) that should be listed on the license as authorized to independently lead source retrieval activities.

6. Pertaining to the transfer of control, please provide a brief description of the transaction that occurred. Please clarify if IRISNDT acquired in full by Apave America and if Apave now the direct owner of the license, or if Apave is indirectly, such as by being a parent company to Apave IRISNDT, in control of the license.
7. As part of the transfer of control process, the NRC takes steps to verify that the acquiring company is legitimate and that there is a basis of confidence that exists that the company will not use licensed materials for illicit purposes. If any Agreement States have approved the requested transfer of control, please provide a copy of the issued license. Alternatively, you may either provide a different type of license issued to Apave America, or a direct subsidiary, by a State or Federal entity. If either option is not available the NRC may schedule a virtual site visit to establish Apave America as a known entity for the purposes of the transfer of control.

In accordance with Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be made available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS), accessible from the NRC Web site at <https://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>.

For continued processing of your application, we request that you submit your response to this letter by Friday, December 5, 2025. In your response, please refer to the license, docket, and control number specified below.
