Enclosed is a copy of proposed revisions to the Kansas Radiological Health Regulations for review and comment by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. We are requesting that the NRC provide comments on this final regulation package back to our program by February 28, 2026. Our revisions address comments provided by the NRC on our current regulations, including, those regulatory changes as defined in RATS IDs 2018-3; 2019-1,2; and 2020-1,2, and 3. We are aware that there are outstanding NRC comments; these responses will come in a separate package.
