SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION – PENDING NRC LICENSE RENEWAL – OSF HEALTHCARE ST. FRANCIS HOSPITAL AND MEDICAL GROUP

Dear Laura Luna,

We have reviewed your NRC license renewal request dated June 30, 2025 (ML25195A257), and have determined that additional information is required for continued processing of the licensing action. As such, your response is requested to address the following items:

1. When reviewing active medical licenses in the State of Michigan, I could not locate an active medical license for Dr. Nuha Krad. Please confirm that Dr. Krad should continue to be listed on the license as an Authorized User and provide their medical license number.
2. The facility diagram provided labeled as “OSF Healthcare St. Francis Hospital Nuclear Medicine Department” appears to indicate a limited are of the facility that was remodeled in 2022, as described in the letter dated April 18, 2022. Please clarify if this diagram indicates the full extent of the areas within the nuclear medicine department where radioactive materials will be used.
3. In the second facility diagram labelled as “OSF Healthcare St. Francis Hospital OVERVIEW OF PET AREA,” it is unclear what this diagram is intended to show. In the above referenced letter dated April 22, 2022, it appears that use of PET isotopes is limited to use within the trailer area only. Please clarify if there are any areas within the main facility where PET isotopes are used, such as patient waiting areas. Additionally, the resolution of the diagram provided is too low to read the provided labels and room numbers, particularly in the shaded area.
4. Please provide a copy of the shielding evaluation for each area where PET isotopes are used.
5. For PET radionuclide use, please provide a brief description of additional radiation safety equipment in use, such as remote handling devices and shielding available such as syringe shields, shielded waste containers, etc.

We request that you submit your response to this letter by Friday, October 17, 2025. In your response, please refer to the license, docket, and control number specified below.
