Mark,

I appreciate the honesty. Withdrawing an action is relatively straightforward – NUREG-1556 Volume 20 Rev 1 addresses withdrawing a licensing action under Section 4.11.1.1 (I wish I was kidding, but hey I need some humor today).

Some highlights of this section include:

- *A decision to formally withdraw an application or amendment should be made by the applicant or licensee.*
- *The applicant's or licensee's request to withdraw the application or amendment may be obtained via telephone (with the conversation documented in a telephone conversation record);*

Please, if you are withdrawing, be extra clear that you are requesting only withdrawing the September 18 letter, which addresses the Y-90 program. I can hold and continue to process the letter dated August 26, which requests the addition of Kousigan Chetipati Vadivelu, M.D., as an AU (35.100, 200, 300), so I can still issue an amendment.

You may elect to resubmit at your discretion. I may or may not get the revised submission assigned to me.
