Subject: Notice of Intent to Pursue Subsequent License Renewal Applications

Reference 1: NRC Regulatory Issue Summary 2009-06, Revision 1, "Importance of Giving the NRC Advance Notice of Intent to Pursue License Renewal," February 26, 2024 (ML24018A240)

Dear Sir or Madam:

In Reference 1, the NRC described the importance of providing advance notice of plans for license renewal to allow the NRC staff to better plan and budget for reviews of applications submitted in accordance with Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (10 CFR) Part 54, "Requirements for Renewal of Operating Licenses for Nuclear Power Plants."

Consistent with Regulatory Issue Summary (RIS) 2009-06, Revision 1 (Reference 1), on November 7, 2024 (ML24312A399), Vistra Operations Company LLC (Vistra) provided the NRC staff advance notification of the intention to submit two Subsequent License Renewal Applications (SLRAs). This letter supersedes the November 7, 2024, letter to provide clarifying information on Vistra's intentions regarding SLRA submittals to assist the NRC staff for budgeting and scheduling consistent with the RIS 2009-06.

In the November 7, 2024 letter, Vistra did not identify individual plant names, instead referring to "Unnamed Vistra Plant." Effective this letter, Vistra no longer requests withholding of plant names. Additionally, via this letter Vistra is including an additional Vistra plant to its intent to pursue subsequent license renewal. Vistra's intentions for three of its plants are listed below.

The SLRA for the Perry Nuclear Power Plant (PNPP) is intended to be submitted within the July to September 2027 time frame. The SLRA for the Beaver Valley Power Station (BVPS), Units 1 and 2, will be submitted within the July to September 2028 time frame and the SLRA for Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station (DBNPS) is intended to be submitted in the July to September 2029 time frame.

There are no new regulatory commitments made in this submittal.
