Holtec International appreciates the NRC's ongoing review of the application to amend Certificate of Compliance (CoC) 72-1032 for the HI-STORM FW MPC Storage System. By email dated September 26, 2025, the NRC staff provided comments on the response to Batch 2 RAI 4-2. On a call during December 11, 2025, Holtec and the NRC staff discussed further clarification on the response to RAI 4-2. Holtec established plans to respond to the NRC staff's comments and provide additional clarification to the RAI 4-2 response by January 30, 2026. This letter contains the additional clarification Holtec is submitting to the NRC for their review of Amendment 10.

The responses to the request are contained in Attachment 1 proprietary version. Attachments 2 and 3 contain the affected pages of the HI-STORM FW FSAR in non-proprietary and proprietary versions. All changes to the FSAR related to this amendment are shown in track change versions, with changes related to the RAI comment responses specifically highlighted in yellow for clarity.
