This refers to your license amendment request dated August 29, 2025. Please find enclosed Amendment No. 86 authorizing Dr. Markus Maria Fitzek for 10 CFR 35.300 and 10 CFR 35.600 uses and Michele Lynn Verst as an authorized medical physicist. Furthermore, we have added the use of the GammaTile Sealed Brachytherapy sources as you requested. Additionally, we removed the following authorized users and isotopes per your request: Dr. Scott L. Ackley; Dr. Zachary Michael Nuffer, Dr. Ramana Yedavalli; and the Iodine-125 and Cesium-137 sources permitted by 10 CFR 35.400.

An environmental assessment for this action was not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(14).

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand and fully implement all the conditions incorporated into the amended license.
