In response to the NRC requirements regarding Change Of Control, Branscome is providing the following responses to facilitate the process.

1. Description of Transaction

On February 25<sup>th</sup>, 2023, the stock of Branscome Inc. was acquired by new ownership – Branscome Holding LLC. As this was a stock sale, all assets, liabilities, and operations were transferred as part of this sale. The company remained registered in Virginia with the [REDACTED] and Articles of Conversion were filed and accepted by the Virginia SCC. Branscome Inc. became Branscome Operating, LLC on February 27<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

Branscome Operating, LLC. is owned and controlled by Branscome Holding LLC. The tax ID [REDACTED] for this entity.

Prior to this sale, Branscome Inc. was owned by Branscome Companies, Inc. Branscome Companies, Inc. was an owned subsidiary of Colas Inc.

2. Changes of Personnel

As a result of the new ownership, structuring the deal as a stock sale, business continuity was maintained and operations functioned in the same manner as before the sale. All Licensees remained and there is no changes to the applicable personnel.

3. Changes of Location, Equipment, and Procedures

The change of control does not impact any of the locations, equipment, or procedures that are currently in place. The geographic footprint of the business is not changed nor are any locations being added or abandoned.

4. Surveillance Records

Branscome states that all required surveillance has been performed, documented, and reviewed. The surveillance program was current at the time of transfer and has maintained this program accordingly since.

5. Decommissioning and Related Records Transfers

Branscome is giving formal confirmation that all records of the evaluations mentioned before have been transferred to the new licensee under this change of control. Pursuant to 10 CFR 30.35(g), we shall maintain drawings and records important to decommissioning and will transfer these records to an NRC or Agreement State licensee before licensed activities are transferred.

6. Transferee's Commitment to Abide by the Transferor's Commitments

Branscome agrees to abide by all constraints, license conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments identified in and attributed to the existing license. NRC Form 313 is provided in this response.

7. Confirmation of agreement of transfer of control.

Branscome agrees to control of the materials and activity, conditions of transfer and that there are no open inspection items currently.

8. Confirmation of abiding all constraints, conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments of the licensed program




