Tree Clearing Timing Request**

Dear Document Control:

Cameco Resources/Crow Butte Resources, Inc. (CBR) is submitting this letter to update the administrative record for the Crow Butte In-Situ Recovery (ISR) Project license renewal of Source Material License Number SUA-1534. This update follows submittal of the Biological Assessment (BA) transmitted to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) on February 19, 2026, under CBR's designation as the non-Federal representative for ESA Section 7 consultation.

Subsequent to that submittal, CBR received correspondence from the NRC indicating that the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (FWS) requested the following clarification regarding timing restrictions associated with the northern long-eared bat:

“Note, timing restrictions have changed throughout the years based on the most up-to-date northern long-eared bat data and previous license condition 9.13(a) had included a tree-clearing avoidance window of June 1 to July 31. If the April 1 – September 30 dates can be accommodated, the NRC will request that CBR submit this commitment under oath and affirmation to the docket.”

CBR has reviewed the requested timing window and hereby commits to implementing the April 1 through September 30 tree-clearing avoidance window as requested by the FWS and communicated through the NRC.

By this letter, CBR submits its formal commitment and affirmation for inclusion in the docket for the ongoing license-renewal review.
