APP-2026-000003	Sweatman, Julia	Good Energy Collective	Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), I am requesting a FOIA appeal from the initial FOIA decision regarding FOIA-2025-000660 provided to us on February 2, 2026. The reasons for this appeal are outlined below. The data received does not match the FOIA request, which targeted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC) facility-level import and procurement data across the front-end fuel cycle (uranium purchases, conversion, enrichment, fabrication, and summary materials). The data provided includes a set of 209 Part 110 export license records from January 2015 through June 2025. Each record is an outbound shipment license (XSNM or XSOU) with foreign destinations. The data does not include import licenses, sourcing or country-of-origin data, SWU or enrichment service records, or facility-level procurement information. While I appreciate the data provided, I am submitting this appeal given that the data does not address the supply chain traceability questions we are researching. In this appeal, I am seeking information related to import licenses and Nuclear Material Control & Accountability (MC&A) records, which I believe will yield more desirable results for our research.	03/06/2026

Streamlining Contested Adjudications in Licensing Proceedings; Proposed Rule; 10 CFR Parts 2, 51, 52, and 54 [NRC-2025-1501; RIN 3150-AL58]

On March 3, 2026, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) published a document in the *Federal Register* ([91 FR 10450](#)) proposing to revise the agency's rules of practice and procedure to streamline contested adjudications in NRC licensing proceedings in response to the Accelerating Deployment of Versatile, Advanced Nuclear for Clean Energy Act of 2024 (ADVANCE Act) and Executive Order 14300, Ordering the Reform of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. Comments are requested by April 2, 2026.

NRC Staff Issues Revision to Certificate of Compliance

On March 4, 2026, the Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards staff issued Revision 1 to TN Americas LLC for Certificate of Compliance 9377 for the TN-32B transportation package (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. [ML26051A006](#)). This revision will allow for a one-time transport of the Department of Energy – Electric Power Research Institute High Burnup Research Cask.

Freedom of Information Act Implementing Regulations; Final Rule; 10 CFR Part 9 [NRC-2024-0044; RIN 3150-AL14]

On March 6, 2026, the NRC published a document in the *Federal Register* ([91 FR 10939](#)) amending its regulations that implement the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) to provide clarity, promote agency accountability, improve efficiency in responding to FOIA requests, update roles and responsibilities, and align the regulations with current Federal best practices for implementing FOIA. The final rule addresses the Department of Justice (DOJ) recommendation that the NRC update its FOIA regulations and incorporate the DOJ's model language for FOIA regulations, where appropriate. The final rule is effective on March 6, 2026.
