


**Radiation Safety Officer Delegation of Authority  
Mercy Memorial Hospital**

Mercy Memorial Hospital d.b.a. ProMedica Monroe Regional Hospital has appointed Kerry Krugh as the Radiation Safety Officer, who agrees to be responsible for implementing the radiation protection program. The licensee through the Radiation Safety Officer, shall ensure that the radiation safety activities are being performed in accordance with licensee approved procedures and regulatory requirements as referenced in 10 CFR 20.1101.

This includes the authority, organizational freedom, time, resources, and management to identify radiation safety problems; initiate, recommend or provide corrective actions; stop unsafe operations; and verify implementation of corrective actions. To investigate deviations from the radiation safety practices approved by facility management and/or the Radiation Safety Committee, if applicable.

Management has hereby delegated the authority necessary to meet these responsibilities, including prohibiting the use of radioactive material by employees who do not meet the necessary requirements and shutting down operations when justified to maintain radiation safety. You are required to notify management if staff does not cooperate and does not address radiation safety issues. 
