NRC Holds Public Meeting to Discuss Proposed Rule

On April 6, 2026, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) hosted a virtual public information meeting to discuss the proposed rule recently published in the *Federal Register* ([91 FR 9733](#)) to revise the NRC regulations in Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (CFR) Section 50.55a. The revisions incorporate by reference the 2023 edition of the American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME) Boiler & Pressure Vessel (BPV) code and three NRC Regulatory Guides listing recent ASME code cases related to the ASME BPV Code, Sections III and XI, and the ASME Operation and Maintenance of Nuclear Power Plants Code. The meeting was attended by industry representatives from Xcel Energy, Westinghouse, the Tennessee Valley Authority, Duke Energy, Dominion Energy, Framatome, Constellation Energy, Entergy, and the Taiwan Power Company, as well as nuclear interest groups such as the Nuclear Energy Institute and the Electric Power Research Institute.

Modernizing Requirements Relating to Physical Protection of Category 1 and Category 2 Quantities of Radioactive Material; Proposed Rule; 10 CFR Part 37 [NRC-2025-1238; RIN 3150-AL51]

On April 9, 2026, the NRC published a document in the *Federal Register* ([91 FR 17893](#)) proposing to revise its regulations relating to physical protection and security of category 1 and category 2 quantities of radioactive material. The NRC is conducting a review and wholesale revision of its regulations consistent with Executive Order 14300, "Ordering the Reform of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission." Comments are requested by May 11, 2026.

The Sunset Rule-Aircraft Impact Assessment; Final Rule; Public Meeting; 10 CFR Part 50 [NRC-2026-0166; RIN 3150-AL63]

On April 8, 2026, the NRC published a document in the *Federal Register* ([91 FR 17757](#)) amending its regulations to insert a conditional sunset date for the requirements for aircraft impact assessment. The action is in response to Executive Order 14270, "Zero-Based Regulatory Budgeting to Unleash American Energy." The NRC has considered public input received on a previous rulemaking to sunset NRC regulations and provides in the document the NRC's response to those public comments that the NRC has deemed significant and adverse. The final rule is effective April 8, 2026.
