SUBJECT: APRIL 2026 ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON REACTOR SAFEGUARDS
(ACRS) FULL COMMITTEE MEETING - TOPICAL REPORTS AND

During the 734th meeting of the Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards (ACRS), April 8 through 9, 2026, the Committee considered the following topical reports (TRs). The Committee previously decided to review this TR. However, additional design information is needed to fully inform the review. Consequently, the Committee does not request to review this document at this time. The Committee will review the implementation of this TR during the associated new reactor design application review.
