SUBJECT: STAFF REQUIREMENTS – MEETING WITH THE ADVISORY  
COMMITTEE ON THE MEDICAL USES OF ISOTOPES

On April 21, 2026, the Commission was briefed on a variety of medical-related topics of regulatory interest by the following members of the Advisory Committee on the Medical Uses of Isotopes (ACMUI): Dr. Hossein Jadvar, ACMUI Chair and Nuclear Medicine Physician; Dr. Richard Harvey, Radiation Safety Officer; Dr. Andrew Einstein, Nuclear Cardiologist, and Josh Mailman, Patients' Rights Advocate. The topics discussed included an overview of ACMUI activities; actions to promote licensing and inspection efficiencies in line with the ADVANCE Act; potential artificial intelligence applications for NRC medical enterprises; and patients' rights advocate's perspectives on patient release involving emerging radiopharmaceutical therapy.

The meeting, which was held in the Commissioners' Hearing Room, One White Flint North, Rockville, Maryland at 10:00 a.m. Eastern Time, was open to members of the public attending in person and via webcast.

The Commission identified no requirements for staff action.
