oppose issuance of a license for the Paducah Laser Enrichment Facility, Docket ID NRC-2025-1007. This is the first commercial laser uranium enrichment facility ever proposed in the United States using technology never commercially deployed anywhere in the world. The draft EIS fails to adequately address groundwater contamination at a site with a documented legacy of contamination from the former Paducah Gaseous Diffusion Plant. I urge the NRC to reject the draft EIS and require a full supplemental environmental impact statement before any licensing action proceeds.
