Affidavit Supporting Request for Withholding from Public Disclosure per 10 CFR 2.390(a)(4)

I, Chris Wagner, Chief Operating Officer of Eden Radioisotopes, LLC (“Eden”) do hereby affirm and state:

1. I am authorized to execute this Affidavit on behalf of Eden. I am further authorized to review information submitted to or discussed with the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and apply for the withholding of information from public disclosure on behalf of Eden.
2. The information sought to be withheld, in its entirety, is contained in Enclosure 2, “Preliminary Safety Analysis Report,” of the Eden letter EDEN-NRC-2026-002 submitting the Construction Permit Application for the Eden Isotope Production Complex.
3. The basis for proposing that the information be withheld is that Eden treats the information as a trade secret, privileged, or as confidential commercial or financial information pursuant to the exemption from public disclosure set forth in the Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"), 5 USC 552(b)(4), and NRC regulations 10 CFR 2.390(a)(4) and 10 CFR 9.17(a)(4). Export controlled information is also marked for withholding per 10 CFR Part 810, “Assistance to Foreign Atomic Energy Activities.”
4. I am knowledgeable of the criteria and procedures used by Eden in designating information as a trade secret, privileged, or as confidential commercial or financial information that would be protected from public disclosure under 10 CFR 2.390(a)(4).
5. Pursuant to 10 CFR 2.390(b)(4), the following is furnished for consideration by the NRC in determining whether the information sought to be withheld from public disclosure should be withheld.
 - a. The information sought to be withheld from public disclosure is owned by Eden or third parties to whom Eden has an obligation to maintain its confidentiality. This information was prepared with the explicit understanding that the information itself would be treated as proprietary and confidential and has been held in confidence by Eden.
 - b. The information sought to be withheld is of a type that is customarily held in confidence by Eden, and there is a rational basis for doing so. The information Eden is requesting to be withheld from public disclosure includes technical information related to the design of the Eden Reactor Facility and Hot Cell (processing) Facility that directly impacts Eden’s business development and commercialization efforts. Disclosures outside Eden of this information are limited to regulatory bodies, customers and potential customers, and their agents, suppliers, licensees, and others with a legitimate need for the information, and then only in accordance with appropriate regulatory provisions or contractual agreements to maintain confidentiality.


c. The information sought to be withheld is transmitted to the NRC in confidence, and under the provisions of 10 CFR 2.390, it is to be received in confidence by the NRC.

d. The information sought to be withheld is not available in public sources.

e. Public disclosure of this non-public information would result in harm to Eden because it would enhance the ability of competitors to provide similar products and services by reducing their expenditure of resources using similar project methods, equipment, testing approach, contractors, or licensing approaches.
