LICENSEE:

The inspection was an examination of the activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector. The inspection findings are as follows:

- 1. Based on the inspection findings, no violations were identified.
- 2. Previous violation(s) closed.
- 3. The violation(s), specifically described to you by the inspector as non-cited violations, are not being cited because they were self-identified, non-repetitive, and corrective action was or is being taken, and the remaining criteria in the NRC Enforcement Policy, to exercise discretion, were satisfied.

1 Non-cited violation(s) were discussed involving the following requirement(s):

10 CFR 35.63(d) states in part that unless otherwise directed by the authorized user, a licensee may not use a dosage if the dosage does not fall within the prescribed dose range.

Contrary to the above without being directed by the authorized user the licensee used dosages falling outside the prescribed dose range. Specifically, the licensee used dosages below the prescribed dose range on three occasions.

This violation is being treated as a non-cited violation, consistent with Section 2.3.2 of the Enforcement Policy.

As a corrective action the licensee will notate the authorized user's direction to use a dosage that falls outside the dosage range.

- 4. During this inspection, certain of your activities, as described below and/or attached, were in violation of NRC requirements and are being cited in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy. This form is a NOTICE OF VIOLATION, which may be subject to posting in accordance with 10 CFR 19.11. (Violations and Corrective Actions)
