Premier Cardiovascular Consultants purchased the practice of Vicky Savas, M.D., P.C. The transaction was finalized in December 2025.

RE: Transfer of Control and License Termination

To whom it may concern,

On or about December 15, 2025, our facility was purchased by Premier Cardiovascular Consultants (PCC). We are therefore requesting the transfer of control to PCC. The transferor license (license #21-32561-01) is to be terminated after the approval of the transfer of control. The facility will remain operational as an address of use of the transferee RAM license. A separate RAM license amendment request will be sent under separate cover to add this address to the transferee RAM license.

Below is the information needed for transfer of control.

- 1. There will be no changes in personnel or duties that relate to the licensed program.

- 3. Describe any changes in the location, facilities, equipment, radiation safety program, use, possession, waste management, or other procedures that relate to the licensed program.**

There will be no changes in the location, facilities, equipment, use, or possession that relate to the licensed program. After the purchase, this practice will be adopting the radiation safety program, waste management, and other procedures currently used by PCC.

- 4. Describe the status of the licensee's facilities, equipment, and radiation safety program, including any known contamination and whether decontamination will occur prior to transfer. Include the status of calibrations, leak tests, area surveys, wipe tests, training, quality control, and related records.**

The licensee's facilities and equipment will remain the same. The facility will be adopting the radiation safety program currently in use by PCC. There is currently no known contamination. All records of calibrations, leak tests, area surveys, wipe tests, training, quality control, and related records are up to date.

- 5. If current decommissioning funding plans (DFP) will be changed as a result of the transfer, the revised DFP should be submitted. If other financial assurance documents will be changed as a result of the transfer, confirm that all financial assurance instruments associated with the license will be held in the transferee's name before the E-2 license is transferred, and as required by 10 CFR 30.35(f), the licensee must, within 30 days, submit financial instruments reflecting such changes.**

- 6. Confirm that all records concerning the safe and effective decommissioning of the facility will be transferred to the transferee or to NRC, as appropriate. These records include documentation of surveys of ambient radiation levels and fixed and/or removable contamination, including methods and sensitivity.**

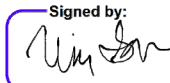

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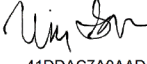
