Subject: Supplement to Application for Order Consenting to Indirect License Transfer

Reference: 1. Holtec Decommissioning International, LLC letter to U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, "Application for Order Consenting to Indirect License Transfer" dated May 14, 2026

In Reference 1, Holtec Decommissioning International, LLC ("HDI"), on behalf of Holtec Pilgrim, LLC, Holtec Indian Point 2, LLC ("IP1 and IP2"), Holtec Indian Point 3, LLC ("IP3") (IP1 and IP2 the owner of Indian Point Nuclear Generating Station 1 and 2, and IP3 the owner of Indian Point Nuclear Generating Station 3, with all three Indian Point units collectively referred to as Indian Point Energy Center ("IPEC")), Oyster Creek Environmental Protection, LLC, and Holtec Big Rock Point, LLC (collectively, "Applicants"), submitted an application pursuant to Section 184 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended ("AEA"), and 10 CFR 50.80 and

10 CFR 72.50 requesting that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (“NRC”) consent to the indirect transfer of control of the above-referenced NRC licenses. Applicants sought NRC consent to implement the second phase of an internal reorganization being undertaken by Holtec International (“Holtec”), including by transferring control of the Applicants to a new affiliate, Decommissioning Asset Management Company, LLC (“DEAMCO”).

Attachment A to Enclosure 2 of the Application included general corporate information required by 10 CFR 50.33(d)(3) for the Applicants, DEAMCO, and its immediate upstream parent, Holtec Holdings, Inc. (“HHI”). The Application also advised the NRC that certain members of the DEAMCO Board of Managers, including the Independent Fiduciary Manager who will exercise independent authority over certain decommissioning-related decisions, and officers of the companies had not yet been appointed. Applicants promised to provide the NRC with the names of the Board of Managers and the officers and directors promptly upon their appointment.

Applicants are submitting this supplement to the Application to provide the information required by 10 CFR 50.33(d)(3) for Applicants, DEAMCO, and HHI. This information is provided in Attachment 1 in the form of a revision to Enclosure 2, Attachment A to the Application. As shown therein, all officers and directors of HHI and DEAMCO are U.S. citizens and each of the owners licensees will be member managed by DEAMCO. The corporate structure and relationship among the Holtec entities remains as stated in the Application.

As noted in Attachment 1, the Independent Fiduciary Manager, who will also serve as President of DEAMCO, will be James A. Ripple, Jr. who has over forty years of experience in the nuclear industry. Mr. Ripple’s resume is included as Attachment 2 to this letter.

Attachment 2 to this letter contains personally identifiable information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, and therefore is exempt from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 2.390. Upon removal of Attachment 2, the remainder of this letter is suitable for public disclosure.
