ISSUANCE OF REQUEST FOR INFORMATION (STC-26-034)

Purpose: To inform Agreement States and Federally recognized Indian Tribes that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has published a request for information regarding the costs and benefits of regulations that the NRC has identified for removal from its regulations at 10 CFR Chapter I.

Background: The notice titled Sunset Provisions; Request for Information, invites public input to inform NRC's implementation of Executive Order (E.O.) 14270, "Zero-Based Regulatory Budgeting to Unleash American Energy" (90 FR 15643; April 9, 2025). The E.O. directs the NRC to offer the public opportunity to comment on the costs and benefits of certain regulations that NRC has identified to be sunset, e.g., removed from the NRC's regulations.
