Subject: Form 361-series OMB clearance renewal -- 30-day notice due to OCIO on 6/22

The 3-year OMB renewal for the event notification NRC Forms 361/361A/361N/361S is coming to a close.

The renewal date is July 31. The 60-day public comment window closes on June 21. OCIO wants the 30-day notice package to them on June 22.

I will need Branch Chief concurrence (email is sufficient) to submit the final 30-day Federal Register notice and associated documentation to OCIO to complete our final steps in the

process. The key documents are

1. Draft 30-day public comment FRN
2. Final Supporting Statement for OMB to approve renewal

I'm including the 60-day FRN and the Draft Supporting Statement for comparison. There was a change since the 60-day notice, to include the new Form 361S for Part 53. We have to include it in our renewal as the rulemaking used our existing 361 clearance. The impact was minor though, a change to the titles of the documents and a few words in the Supporting Statement to explain the addition. The Supporting Statement may still yet need revision if any public comments come in this week. There have been none so far, but NEI has made the same comment about the burden estimate for past renewals.

I've attached what are almost the final Forms – we've made a few minor changes as part of this renewal cycle. Plus, the Forms person is making some formatting changes as part of their process. I should get the final Forms on Tuesday.

All of this is notionally due back to OCIO on June 22 – the day after the public comment window closes. I'm getting this to you now so when I finalize the documents, you'll be able to give the concurrence. I'm also going to have LaKashia go ahead and start putting some things in ADAMS that I don't expect to change – what actually gets sent to OCIO is your concurrence email and the ML for the ADAMS package with all the documents. I'm also going to give her a heads-up we'll need some timely ADAMS uploads on the 22nd.

PS: If you're thinking about the pending 50.72 rulemaking, I've talked with the rulemaking PM and there will be a revised Form 361 in their final package. As soon as I finalize Form 361 for the renewal I'll be sending it to the PM to be incorporated.
