This refers to your license amendment request dated April 6, 2026. Please find enclosed Amendment No. 6 authorizing Beau Handley as your Radiation Safety Officer. Regarding your request for an Associate Radiation Safety Officer: the NRC does not identify Associate Radiation Safety Officers on non-medical licenses. While you may designate an individual to this title and allow them to perform duties under the supervision and authority delegated by the Radiation Safety Officer, the NRC will not list any additional individuals on your license.

An environmental assessment for this action was not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(a)(10).

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand and fully implement all the conditions incorporated into the amended license. You will be periodically inspected by the NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with the NRC will result in enforcement action(s) against you. This could include issuance of a Notice of Violation, or Imposition of a Civil Penalty, or an Order Suspending, Modifying or Revoking Your License as specified in the NRC Enforcement Policy.
