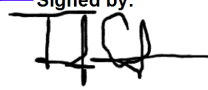
Submission of *newcleo* Americas, LLC Regulatory Engagement Plan for the U.S. LFR-AS-200 Reactor Technology

The purpose of this letter is to submit the subject regulatory engagement plan to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) on behalf of *newcleo* Americas LLC (*newcleo*) and our family of companies. This plan provides administrative information and proposed engagements for *newcleo*'s LFR-AS-200 reactor technology as introduced to the NRC staff on March 7, 2026.
