SUBJECT: Consent to Transfer of Facility Operating License No. R-23 (Docket No. 50-059) for the AGN-201M Reactor from Texas A&M University to the Texas A&M Engineering Experiment Station

As President of Texas A&M University and the current holder of Facility Operating License No. R-23, I hereby consent to the transfer of the license to the Texas A&M Engineering Experiment Station (TEES). This transfer is an internal organizational change within the Texas A&M University System and involves no physical, operational, or safety changes to the AGN-201M reactor, which remains in its approved mothballed, possession-only configuration at the Nuclear Science Center.

I support the License Amendment Request submitted by TEES pursuant to 10 CFR 50.80 and 10 CFR 50.90. TEES already holds Facility Operating License No. R-83 for the Nuclear Science Center Reactor at the same facility and is fully qualified to assume responsibility for R-23.

I request that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission approve this transfer and issue the conforming license amendment.
