SUBJECT: AEROTEST OPERATIONS, INC. - ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RESPONSE TO
NRC INSPECTION REPORT 050-00228/2026-001 AND NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. Slaughter:

This letter acknowledges receipt of your June 23, 2026, correspondence (Agencywide Document and Access Management System [ADAMS] Accession No. ML26175A287) sent in response to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Inspection Report 05000228/2026-001 (ML26152A173) dated June 11, 2026. In your letter, you provided a basis for why Notice of Violations (NOVs) A and C should be withdrawn and why NOVs B and D, should be recharacterized as minor violations.

Violation A involved failure to ensure radiation monitors were calibrated periodically for the radiation measured and Violation C involved failure to make surveys of areas necessary to comply with the regulations of 10 CFR 20.1301(a)(1). Violation B involved failure to have a portable survey instrument (neutron) for measuring fast and thermal neutron dose rates from 0.1 mrem/hr to 1.0 rem/hr available at the facility as required by Technical Specification 7.5. Violation D involved a change made to the facility without obtaining a license amendment as required by 10 CFR 50.59(c)(1). In accordance with Section 2.8 of the NRC Enforcement Manual, the NRC is currently reviewing your basis for contesting the violations. Accordingly, the NRC's goal is to provide the results of our evaluation by written response within 90 days of the receipt of your June 23, 2026, letter.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, "Public Inspections, Exemptions, Requests for Withholding," of the NRC's "Agency Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be made available electronically for public inspection in the NRC's Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS).
