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SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF JUNE 11, 2026 CLOSED PRE-APPLICATION
ENVIRONMENTAL MEETING WITH WESTINGHOUSE COLUMBIA FUEL
FABRICATION FACILITY

On June 11, 2026, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held a virtual closed pre-application meeting with Westinghouse Columbia Fuel Fabrication Facility (Westinghouse). Westinghouse had requested this meeting to discuss the environmental review for its proposed low enriched uranium plus (LEU+) facility expansion at its currently licensed fuel fabrication facility in Hopkins, South Carolina that will be used to manufacture light water reactor fuel enriched up to 8 percent uranium-235. The meeting was closed to the public for discussion of proprietary information. The meeting notice and agenda, dated June 8, 2026, is available in the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) at Accession No. ML26159A160. Westinghouse's presentations (slides) for the closed (non-public) meeting (ML26166A427 non-public) are in ADAMS.

The discussion focused on a description of the environmental review activities accomplished to date and the schedule of remaining activities to be completed by submittal of the application. Westinghouse indicated that their documentation will use the 2022 environmental impact statement as the baseline for adding the LEU+ facility expansion information.

In accordance with Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* Part 2, "Agency Rules of Practice and Procedure," a copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room (PDR) or from the Publicly Available Records component of the NRC's ADAMS.
