Re: Request Review for New Mexico Non-Standard Materials License Conditions

Dear Ms. Cook:

The New Mexico Environment Department respectfully requests your review and approval of the following non-standard license conditions for source and special nuclear material (SNM) licensees. These license conditions are intended to remind such licensees of their reporting obligations to the Commission under 10 CFR 150.

The proposed license conditions are as follows:

- 1. Additional requirements for source material licensees:**
 - a. The licensee must notify the NRC immediately of any applicable reports required 10 CFR §150.17(c) and (d), and then notify the Department. Immediate source material reports to the NRC are required for “any incident in which an attempt has been made or is believed to have been made to commit a theft or unlawful diversion of more than 6.8 kg [15 pounds] of such material at any one time or 68 kg [150 pounds] of such material in any one calendar year.”**
 - b. The licensee must submit to the NRC, with a printout copy to the Department, any applicable reports required by 10 CFR 150.16 “Submission to Commission of nuclear material transaction reports”, or 150.17 “Submission to the Commission of nuclear material status reports”. The licensee shall comply with 10 CFR 150.17(a) when applicable.**
- 2. Additional requirements for special nuclear material licensees:**
 - a. The licensee must notify the NRC immediately of any applicable reports required 10 CFR §150.16(b) and then notify the Department. Immediate reports to the NRC are required for “any incident in which an attempt has been made or is believed to have been made to commit a theft or unlawful diversion special nuclear material which the licensee is authorized to possess or any incident in which an attempt has been made, or is believed to have been made, to commit a theft or unlawful diversion of special nuclear material.”**

- b. The licensee must submit to the NRC, with a printout copy to the Department, any applicable reports required by 10 CFR 150.16 "Submission to Commission of nuclear material transaction reports", or 150.17 "Submission to the Commission of nuclear material status reports". The licensee shall comply with 10 CFR 150.17(a) when applicable.**
