17. Scope and Observations: This was an unannounced routine inspection of a 32-bed community hospital authorized to perform diagnostic administrations of radiopharmaceuticals. The facility had one full-time technologist who performed one to six exams each week including hepatobiliary, lung, bone, gastric, and cardiac studies. The licensee received unit doses from a licensed nuclear pharmacy. The licensee utilized a medical physicist consultant to perform instrument calibrations and quarterly audits of the radiation safety program. The inspector toured the nuclear medicine department and interviewed the technologist. All areas were properly posted and adequately secured. There were no procedures performed during the inspection. The technologist demonstrated dose administration, including preparation and disposal, as well as receipt of packages containing licensed material, survey instrument and dose calibrator QC, daily area surveys, and wipe tests. The inspector discussed waste disposal, spill response, and emergency procedures with the technologist. The inspector found that the technologist was knowledgeable of radiation protection principles and regulatory requirements. The technologist wore appropriate PPE and dosimetry and practiced ALARA. The inspector reviewed a sections of records related to dosimetry, quarterly audits, package receipt, area surveys, waste disposal logs, training, dose calibrator linearity and accuracy, inventory, leak tests, area surveys, and wipe tests. Interviews with the technologist demonstrated appropriate knowledge of radiation safety concepts and practices. A review of dosimetry records indicated no exposures of concern. Independent surveys showed radiation levels consistent with licensee postings and records. No violations of NRC requirements were identified as a result of this inspection.
