Enclosure 1 provides the background, basis for approval of the UUSA ISSP and proposed change to SNM-2010 License Condition 10. Enclosure 2 includes the marked up version of the proposed UUSA ISSP for Classified Systems. Revision bars, strikethroughs, and underlines were utilized.
