On June 25, 2026, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) completed an inspection at Louisiana Energy Services, LLC doing business as Urenco USA (UUSA). On June 25, 2026, the NRC inspectors discussed the results of this inspection with you and other members of your staff. The results of this inspection are documented in the enclosed report.

One Severity Level IV violation is documented in this report. We are treating this violation as a non-cited violation (NCV) consistent with Section 2.3.2 of the Enforcement Policy.

If you contest the violation or the significance or severity of the violation documented in this inspection report, you should provide a response within 30 days of the date of this inspection report, with the basis for your denial, to the NRC, ATTN: Document Control Desk, Washington, DC 20555-0001; with copies to the Director, Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards; and the Director, Office of the Chief Nuclear Reactor Inspector.
