AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE NEW YORK DEPARTMENT OF STATE

AND

CONSTELLATION ENERGY GENERATION, LLC.

TO STAY THE COASTAL CONSISTENCY REVIEW PERIOD ASSOCIATED WITH A
NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION RELICENSING APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF THE
OPERATING LICENSE OF R.E. GINNA NUCLEAR POWER PLANT
IN THE TOWN OF ONTARIO, WAYNE COUNTY, LAKE ONTARIO

This stay agreement applies to federal consistency review for the proposed project under review by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission for a facility operating license renewal under 10 CFR Part 54 authorization(s). The proposed project is subject to NYS Department of State (DOS) review pursuant to the Coastal Zone Management Act (CZMA), 16 U.S.C. § 1451, et. seq., and the CZMA's implementing regulations at 15 CFR part 930, subpart D. In accordance with 15 CFR § 930.60 (b), and in consideration of the parties' mutual interest that the State have additional time to fully assess the proposed project's consistency with the state's enforceable policies and to await Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) determination of the need for Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) in accordance with 10 CFR Part 51, DOS and Constellation Energy Generation, LLC, mutually agree to the following dates and to stay DOS's CZMA six-month review period.

DOS commenced its 6-month review period on: June 30, 2026

The 6-month review period was originally scheduled to end on: December 30, 2026

This stay will begin on: July 24, 2026

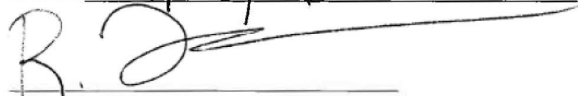
This stay will end on: January 4, 2027, with 159 days remaining in the review period.

Unless the review period is revoked, modified, or extended by mutual agreement of the undersigned, DOS will issue a consistency determination on the proposed project on or before the close of business: June 11, 2027.

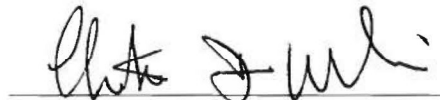
DOS and Constellation Energy Generation LLC. mutually agree that DOS may issue its consistency decision during the stay period and before the end of the stay if DOS determines it has received sufficient information.

Christopher D. Wilson has been authorized, consistent with Constellation's Articles of Organization, Amendments, and By-Laws, as verified by the legal department of Constellation Energy Generation, LLC, to act with full authority on behalf of Constellation Energy Generation, LLC to bind the LLC in this Agreement, which authority has not been amended or revoked and is in full force and effect on this date.
