Dear Sir or Madam,

This letter is to inform the NRC Material Licensing Branch of an upcoming change of control of the SABIC Innovative Plastics U.S., LLC facility in Mt. Vernon, IN, currently operating under NRC Radioactive Materials License No. 13-10455-01 (the "Mt. Vernon Facility").

1. A new license application will not be required. The current licensee, SABIC Innovative Plastics US LLC (the "Licensee"), will continue to hold the current Radioactive Material License 13-10455-01, valid through January 31, 2040.
2. The ultimate new owner of the Licensee will be Mutares SE & Co. KGaA, with its registered address at Arnulfstr. 19, 80335 Munich, Germany ("Mutares"). The Mt. Vernon Facility's mailing address will remain at 1 Lexan Lane, Mt. Vernon, Indiana. 47620.
3. Saudi Arabian-based Saudi Basic Industries Corporation ("SABIC"), the current, ultimate parent company of the Licensee, has signed an agreement to sell its Engineering Thermoplastics ("ETP") business in the Americas and European region to German-based Mutares. The ETP business manufactures polycarbonate ("PC"), polybutylene terephthalate ("PBT"), and acrylonitrile butadiene styrene ("ABS") resins and compounds at manufacturing sites located in Mt. Vernon, Indiana; Ottawa, Illinois; Bay St. Louis, Mississippi; Burkville, Alabama; Tampico, Mexico; Campinas, Brazil; Cartagena, Spain; and Bergen op Zoom, the Netherlands. Completion of the transaction is anticipated in Q3 2026.
4. Upon completion of the sale detailed above, (i) the Licensee will continue to directly own the Mt. Vernon Facility, and (ii) Mutares will indirectly own all membership interests in the Licensee. There is an anticipated name change for



the Licensee; we will duly report the name change once the new name is confirmed.

5. There are no anticipated changes regarding the location, facilities, equipment, or operating and safety procedures. There are no effects on currently registered devices.
6. The site Radiation Safety Officer will be Mr. Jacob Littlefield, pending approval per the amendment request for license no. 13-10455-01, mail control number: 659337. 7. Licensed material shall be used by, or under the supervision of authorized individuals set forth in Radioactive Materials License No. 13-10455-01, Condition 12A and 12B.
8. We attest SABIC Innovative Plastics US LLC, as the direct owner of the Mt. Vernon Facility and licensee of record, will continue to abide by all commitments, constraints, conditions, requirements and representations previously made to this Agency. The Licensee is not aware of any changes to be implemented by the new parent company, Mutares, to the current licensed program upon closing of the sale (expected in Q3 2026). The Licensee will submit a complete description of proposed changes (if any are to be enacted) regarding the licensed program after closing of the referenced sale.
9. Separate documentation affirming the change in ownership will be provided to the NRC once the sale is completed. As of this date there are no open non-conformities on record or pending notices of violation.

A completed NRC Form 313, signed by management, is enclosed in this packet along with the required supporting documentation.
