On Tuesday, July 7, the NRC staff sent an email to initiate and conduct NHPA Section 106 consultation for the aforementioned project, which stated:

“The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is considering a license request from Orano Enrichment USA, LLC (Orano) to construct and operate a gaseous centrifuge uranium enrichment facility in Roane County, Tennessee, to be known as Project IKE (Project).

As part of the NRC’s licensing review, the NRC staff is conducting Section 106 consultation under the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as amended (NHPA). See attached correspondence.

The NRC staff has made a finding of no historic properties affected for the undertaking. Pursuant to 36 CFR 800, the NRC staff invites you to submit any comments or concerns that you may have to offer on the NRC’s Section 106 consultation and historic and cultural resources evaluation.”
