During the week of October 5 - 9, 2026, the NRC will perform a baseline radiation safety inspection at Browns Ferry Nuclear Plant (NRC inspection procedure 71125.01).

Experience has shown that this inspection is resource-intensive for both the NRC inspectors and your staff. In order to minimize the impact to your onsite resources and to ensure a productive inspection, we are requesting in advance documents needed for this activity. It is important that all of these documents are up-to-date, and complete, thereby minimizing the number of additional documents requested during the preparation, and/or the onsite portions of the inspection. The NRC requests that these documents be provided to the inspectors no later than September 25, 2026.
