Dear Ms. Pfaff, Ms. Gubbi, and Mr. Humphreys,

In accordance with Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations*, Section 50.91(b), I am seeking any comments you may have on the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) proposed no significant hazards consideration for a license amendment request submitted by PSEG Nuclear LLC (the licensee) for the Salem Generating Station, Units 1 and 2, and Hope Creek Generating Station.

Please reply if the State of New Jersey has comments on the proposed no significant hazards consideration for the following license amendment request: "Application to Revise Technical Specifications to Adopt TSTF-599, Revision 1, 'Eliminate Periodic Surveillance Test of Simultaneous Start of Redundant Diesel Generators'" (NRC Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML26148A253).

The proposed amendment would modify the technical specifications (TS) for Salem Generating Station, Units 1 and 2 (DPR-70 and DPR-75), and Hope Creek Generating Station (NPF-57) to adopt Technical Specifications Task Force (TSTF) Traveler TSTF-599, Revision 1. Specifically, the proposed changes would eliminate the periodic surveillance requirement that verifies all required diesel generators achieve rated frequency and voltage within a specified time period when started simultaneously. The amendment request includes associated changes to the TS pages for both Salem and Hope Creek as described in the application dated May 27, 2026.

The proposed no significant hazards consideration for this amendment request was published in the *Federal Register* on July 21, 2026 (91 FR 45833).
