

ADAMS TEMPLATE QUESTIONS

Example: License Amendment Package (TAC MA1234) which consists of the following items:

1. Transmittal Letter (*amda1234.wpd*) requires signature
2. Service List (*seabrook.sl*)
3. Amendment (*amda1234.wpd*) requires signature
4. Changes to Technical Specifications (*amda1234.wpd* and hardcopy pages)
5. Safety Evaluation (*amda1234.wpd*)
6. Bi-weekly issuance (*bwia1234.wpd*) requires signature and is modified prior to sending to bi-weekly notice coordinator.

Questions:

1. What is the current status of electronic signatures?
2. Is letterhead logo required and, if so, how is it going to be added?
3. Will concurrence page be added to ADAMS
4. Item 4 is currently comprised of an electronic file and Technical Specification pages supplied by the licensee. Should we combine the two into one electronic file? Who will scan the TS pages. How will we update all the TSs books?
5. Should items 1 through 5 all be combined into one electronic file?
