UPDATE OF PSE&G RESPONSE TO NRC GENERIC LETTER 98-01 SALEM NUCLEAR GENERATING STATION UNITS NOS. 1 AND 2 HOPE CREEK NUCLEAR GENERATING STATION FACILITY OPERATING LICENSES DPR-70, DPR-75 AND NPF-57 (TAC NOS. MA-1883, MA-1884 AND MA-1845)

## Gentlemen:

This letter provides the final status of Public Service Electric & Gas Company's actions related to Generic Letter 98-01, "Year 2000 Readiness of Computer Systems at Nuclear Power Plants." In the previous response to Generic Letter 98-01, dated October 5, 1999, PSE&G reported that three (3) Salem Unit 1 mission critical systems remained to be completed during the unit's current refueling outage. As of October 18, 1999, work on these systems has been completed. Thus, all mission critical systems of both Salem and Hope Creek nuclear generating stations have been declared "Y2K Ready".
