SUBJECT: Limerick Generating Station, Units 1 and 2
Licensed Operator Renewal Application

Dear Mr. Miller:

This letter is a request for a license amendment to reflect the restoration of participation in the operator requalification program of the following senior operator. A license amendment was issued on March 2, 1998, at the time of suspension of participation in the operator requalification program.

Since the licensed operator has not continuously attended requalification training required by 10CFR55.59(a)(1) and (2), "additional training" is required as specified in 10CFR55.59(b). This training has been satisfactorily completed and consisted of 23 hours of one-on-one training with Job Performance Measures (JPMs), panel walkdowns and practice exams. Also 50 hours of simulator training with a crew of licensed operators and/or SRO certified instructors was completed.

A comprehensive requalification exam was satisfactorily completed on September 20, 1999. The exam consisted of two simulator dynamic scenarios, 10 JPMs and a 30 question written examination.

Since the licensed operator has not been actively performing the functions of a senior operator the requirements of 10CFR55.53(f) apply. An authorized representative of the facility licensee shall certify (1) That the qualifications and status of the licensee are current and valid and (2) That the licensee has completed a minimum of 40 hours of shift functions under the direction of a senior operator in the position to which the individual will be assigned.

The applicant meets the requirements of 10CFR55.53(f)(1) since qualifications and status are current and valid. NRC Region 1 staff has informed us that NRC Form 398 is not required for this submittal.

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Chung, MICHAEL

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The licensee will not meet the requirements of 55.53(f)(2), (i.e. a minimum of forty (40) hours of shift functions under the direction of a senior operator in the position to which the individual will be assigned). It is not intended for this individual to actively perform the functions of a senior operator. This individual will be a plant staff license holder and maintain an inactive status. Requalification training will be attended including examinations. The requirements of 55.53(f)(2) will be completed if the need to assign this individual active senior licensed duties becomes a necessity.

The licensee is required to meet the requirements of 10CFR55.21 "Medical examination" by having a medical examination by a physician every two years. 10CFR55.23 "Certification" requires an authorized representative of the facility licensee complete and sign Form NRC-396.

The applicant has completed the required medical examination performed by a physician within the previous two years. Form NRC-396 is being submitted as an attachment to this submittal.


The licensee is required to comply with the 10CFR26 "Fitness For Duty Programs".

The applicant has completed supervisor FFD refresher training within the nominal 12 month frequency specified in 10CFR26.21(b) and 10CFR26.22(b). The applicant has been granted unescorted access to the protected area in accordance with 10CFR26.

This applicant has a continued need for his license, has competently and safely carried out his licensed duties, and will continue to be engaged in plant operations directly as Operations Senior Manager. This applicant has satisfactorily completed the approved requalification program.
