




Washington State University wishes to clarify our reciprocity agreement for research on the lakes (Petit, Alturas, Redfish and Stanley) in the Sawtooth Mountains of Idaho. This phase of research continues the primary productivity studies performed in 1997 and 1998 on those lakes. This next trip will commence on October 21, 1999 and continues through October 25, 1999. NRC Form 241 is attached for your convenience.
