Dear Mr. Terry:

The submittal of a semi-annual material balance report is required by 10 CFR Part 74, Section 74.13(a)(1). The report is required to be submitted within 30 days of March 31 and September 30, on an annual basis. By letter dated October 28, 1999, you informed us that you are not able to submit the subject report, as required, due to the ongoing refueling outage of CPSES, Unit 1, and other resource constraints. Your letter requests a schedule extension to allow the subject report to be submitted by November 15, 1999.

We have reviewed your request for a schedule extension for submittal of the semi-annual material balance report and conclude that good cause has been shown for a schedule extension. Accordingly, we conclude that, in accordance with 10 CFR Part 74, Section 74.13(a)(1), submittal of the subject semi-annual material balance report, by November 15, 1999, is acceptable.
