The staff has had ongoing discussions with NCDENR regarding holding a meeting on this issue since they made their original request for a meeting on behalf of several local government agencies and individual citizens in their letter of February 10, 1999. As the hearing proceeds, the staff will continue to evaluate the need for a public meeting on this amendment request.
