Subject: Nuclear Laundry Exposures

Dear Mr. Serig:

We spoke a few weeks ago about the referenced subject. Interstate Nuclear Services is by far the largest commercial nuclear laundry in the country. We have 10 US nuclear laundry facilities. We accumulated info on all full time full-year employees for the calendar year 1998; nearly 250 employees total. We only included full-year employees to avoid the bias that we discussed that might be introduced into the data by included part-year employees. If anything, this data is biased high since it includes all maintenance personnel that historically received most of the highest exposures at INS.

The totals are as follows:

80.53% in the less than 50 mrem/yr category
19.47% in the 51-500 mrem/yr category
