Re: University of Florida Training Reactor
Facility License R-56, Docket No. 50-83

As required by our Technical Specifications, Section 6.6.3, Paragraph (1), we are reporting a significant change in our facility organization at Level 1 which is the level responsible for the University of Florida Training Reactor (UFTR) facility's licenses, charter, and site administration.

Dr. Charles Young was approved by the Florida SUS Board of Regents and assumed the position of Interim President of the University of Florida, effective November 1, 1999 until a permanent president can be identified in a national search. Dr. Young replaced former UF president, John V. Lombardi. As interim president, Dr. Young assumes responsibility for Level 1 administration of the UFTR along with the Interim Dean of the College of Engineering and the Chairman of the Nuclear and Radiological Engineering Department below him.
