SUBJECT: INTEGRATED MATERIALS PERFORMANCE EVALUATION
PROGRAM (IMPEP) REVIEW OF WASHINGTON RADIATION
CONTROL PROGRAM

This memorandum transmits to the Management Review Board (MRB) a proposed final report (Attachment 1) documenting the IMPEP review of the Washington Radiation Control Program. The review of the Washington program was conducted by an interoffice team during the period of August 30 - September 3, 1999. The team issued a draft report to Washington on October 8, 1999, for factual comment. Washington sent factual comments by electronic mail dated October 22, 1999 from John Erickson, Director, Division of Radiation Protection, Washington State Department of Health (Attachment to proposed final report). Attachment 2, Response to Washington Comments to the Draft report, documents the IMPEP team responses and revisions as a result of Washington's comments.

Based on the findings, the review team recommends to the MRB that the State be found satisfactory for all nine performance indicators. Additionally, the team recommends that Washington's program, as a whole, be considered adequate to protect public health and safety and compatible with NRC's regulatory program.

The MRB meeting to consider the Washington report is scheduled for **Tuesday, November 16, 1999 from 2:00 - 4:00 p.m. in Two White Flint North, Room 2-B-5.** In accordance with Management Directive 5.6, the meeting is open to the public. The agenda for that meeting is attached (Attachment 3).
