Dear Sir/Madam:

By letter dated May 27, 1997, PECO Energy provided a follow-up response for Peach Bottom Atomic Power Station (PBAPS) Units 2 and 3, and Limerick Generating Station (LGS) Units 1 and 2, regarding NRC Generic Letter 96-06. PECO Energy made a commitment in the May 27, 1997 letter to inform the NRC of PECO Energy's course of action that will address the susceptible components or systems identified. This letter fulfills that commitment.

At the conclusions of the twelfth PBAPS Unit 3 Refueling Outage (3R12) and the fifth LGS Unit 2 Refueling Outage (2R05) which occurred in October and April 1999, respectively, all physical changes (i.e., installation of thermal relief valves) detailed in our letter dated May 27, 1997, were completed. These actions complete PECO Energy's commitments regarding GL 96-06.


