Subject: ISI Improvement Plan Update

Reference: Letter from J. P. Dimmette, Jr. (ComEd), to USNRC, "ISI Improvement Plan," SVP 99-019, dated February 11, 1999.

The purpose of this letter is to provide a status of our Inservice Inspection (ISI) Improvement Plan. This plan was to be implemented in four phases. Phase I of this plan identified the initial improvement plan. Phase II was focused on resolution of all issues that could potentially affect the full compliance of Unit 1 inspections through the Second Period of this ASME Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code, Section XI Interval. Phase I and Phase II were completed earlier as reported in the referenced letter. Phase III comprises the resolution of all assessment issues. These issues were completed on the dates presented below.

Complete ISI Program Plan Revision for 3 <sup>rd</sup> Interval	March 24, 1999
Completion of Boundary Basis Documents	March 28, 1999
Completion of Selection Documents & Schedule	April 15, 1999

The final phase, Implementation of ISI Maintenance and Control, was implemented during the first quarter of 1999 and completed on October 27, 1999.

The ISI Program Plan documents have been processed through Document Control and are readily available for your review.


